

Micro Advantage / Vision Net Email Server Upgrade

Samsung Galaxy – How to Modify Email Account Settings

From the Home screen, swipe up or down from the center of the display to access the apps screen. (Note: this applies only to Standard mode and the default Home screen layout)

Tap Email icon.

Tap the Menu icon (upper left).

Tap the Gear icon.

From the Accounts section, select the appropriate email address.

From the Advanced settings section, tap Server Settings.

From the Account section, edit the following:

User name: YOUR COMPLETE EMAIL ADDRESS

Password: UPDATE ONLY IF INSTRUCTED TO DO SO

For the Incoming server section, use the following (you will see either POP or IMAP displayed):

POP3/IMAP server: **mailhost.visn.net**

Security type: **SSL**

Port: **995 if POP ; 993 if IMAP**

For the Outgoing server section, use the following:

SMTP server: **mailhost.visn.net**

Security type: **StartTLS, TLS or SSL**

Port: **587**

Require authentication to send emails - Tap the switch to **ON**.

Ensure the Email address, User name and Password (UPDATE PASSWORD IF INSTRUCTED TO DO SO) are entered correctly.

Tap DONE (at the bottom).
